

Notts LTA County Captains Code



of Conduct

- 1) Captains must respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every player
- 2) Captains must place the wellbeing and safety of each player above all other considerations, including development and performance and report any safeguarding concerns through the appropriate channels.
- 3) Junior Captains must be LTA Accredited and adhere to all the guidelines laid down by the LTA.
- 4) Captains must strive to promote and develop their age groups. Working with other coaches to attract new suitable participants.
- 5) Captains must work closely with the Performance Co-ordinator and respond to communications in a timely manner.
- 6) Captains must develop an appropriate working relationship with players and parents of their age groups.
- 7) Captains must strive to develop players level within their age groups by encouraging them to enter relevant tournaments and taking part in match practices.
- 8) Captains must ensure sessions are relevant to age and playing level of their groups.

- 9) Captains must promote high standards of behaviour by their own example both on and off the court during competition. Alcohol must not be consumed during Junior competitions (incl. evenings). Inappropriate language must not be used or tolerated.
- 10) Captains must engage in team preparations for County Cup Events and complete a report following the event for the Notts Social Media Platforms.
- 11) Captains must give suitable notice if they are not able to attend a training session or event.
- 12) Captains must ensure that County approved kit is worn by themselves and their team during competition.
